Dear ILC students, parents, guardians and families:

With increasingly positive data regarding the reducing spread of COVID, the Minister of Education, Rob Fleming, announced a plan to begin a gradual return to school.

District and School based Health and Safety Committees, have been working with recently released safety guidelines to ensure that students can begin to safely access support in the school prior to the end of the school year.

It is important to clarify what students can expect when they return to school:

- Teachers will continue to deliver their courses via a “remote” delivery model - teachers will not be delivering different lessons in the classroom.
- As of **June 1st** students may physically go to ILC, one day a week, to meet with their teachers to receive academic support for the content being delivered via the “remote” delivery model.
This will be done in a limited capacity -- see below.

Weekly Schedule: Students will attend ILC based on Alpha - by Last Name as follows:

Monday : Last names A – F	Within assigned Learning Zone
Tuesday: Last names G – L	Within assigned Learning Zone
Wednesday: Last names M – R	Within assigned Learning Zone
Thursday: Last names S – Z	Within assigned Learning Zone

- An in-person return to school is **voluntary**, however continued engagement in remote learning course work is not. We encourage students to continue with their progress in course work.

Evening Satellite - Students should contact their teacher to arrange an appointment time.

Parkland Satellite - Students should contact their teacher to arrange an appointment time.

Technology Access

School based mobile devices were distributed to students in need, to ensure they had the ability to work remotely. Students will be able to retain these devices until the end of the school year. As a result, students who are hoping to access technology while at school are encouraged to bring their own device as school resources may be limited.
