

Minimum Wage

All employees in British Columbia are entitled to be paid minimum wage at the rates set out in this factsheet. Minimum wage rates are as follows:

General minimum wage: \$10.25 per hour

Liquor server minimum wage: \$9.00 per hour

For more information on the minimum wage rate for liquor servers, please refer to the *Minimum Wage Rate for Liquor Servers* factsheet.

Live-in home support workers: \$102.50 per day or part day worked.

Live-in camp leaders: \$82 for each day or part day worked.

Resident Caretakers:

- for an apartment building containing 9 to 60 suites: \$615 per month plus \$24.65 for each suite;
- for an apartment building containing more than 60 suites: \$2,094.84 per month.

Mushrooms	\$ 0.235/ pound
Peaches	\$ 18.13/ 1/2 bin (12.6 cu. ft.)
Pears	\$ 19.21/ bin (27.1 cu. ft.)
Peas	\$ 0.292/ pound
Prune plums	\$ 19.21/ 1/2 bin (13.7 cu. ft.)
Raspberries	\$ 0.357/ pound
Strawberries	\$ 0.343/ pound
Daffodils*	\$0.137/ bunch (10 stems)



*Piece rates for hand harvested crops include 4% vacation pay with the exception of daffodils, which requires vacation pay to be paid on top of the piece rate.
