

SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS 2020/2021

Full Application Package includes:

(1) District Application form, (2) Application letter, (3) Resume, (4) Transcript, (5) Reference letter

1. District/Authority (6 awards of \$1250 each for ILC)

Criteria:

Student must have **Canadian Citizenship** or **permanent resident status** and fulfill graduation requirements by **August 31, 2021**

Graduating student who has excelled in one of: indigenous languages & culture, fine arts, applied skills, physical activity, international languages, community service, or trades

Proceeding to a post-secondary career orientated program

Student has 5 years to redeem the \$1250 voucher

Student pays tuition, and receives reimbursement at later date**

Application deadline: May 5th

2. District Education (1 award of \$500)

Criteria:

Outstanding student who plans to enter the teaching profession

Selection based on academic achievement and extra-curricular activities

SIN number required

Application deadline: May 5thth

3. Saanich Fruit Growers Scholarship (1 award of \$500)

Criteria:

To support an outstanding student who intends to pursue work or further education in agriculture, horticulture or land use

SIN number required

Application deadline: May 5th

4. Canadian Federation of University Women (1 award of \$1000)

(TBA awaiting confirmation)

Criteria:

Graduating female student, Canadian citizen

Pursuing post-secondary education

Proof of acceptance to post secondary institution and indication of intention to begin studies in their graduation year

Application deadline: May 5th

5. Saanich Teacher's Association Scholarship (STA) (1 award of \$1000)

Criteria:

graduating student who:

- a) has expressed interest in furthering their education
- b) has demonstrated leadership, within the school or community, in the area of interest they are planning to pursue after graduation; and
- c) has written a 250 word essay that explains their area of leadership and their educational goals.

Payment will be made to the recipient upon proof of paid tuition within three (3) years of receiving the scholarship

Application deadline: May 5th.

6. Coast Capital Standing Tall Award (2 awards of \$3500 for the District)

Awarded to a **June 2021** graduating student who plans to attend an accredited Canadian university, college, or technical school in the fall of 2019.

Acknowledges a student who has faced significant hardships and has demonstrated a commitment to continue their education.

Significant hardships include poverty, health, family issues, personal loss, and lack of supports i.e., youth who are or have been in gov't care

Schools submit one candidate - District committee chooses recipients

Application deadline: **April 28th to ILC and April 30th to SBO** (full application package including SIN number and Coast Capital application)

7. Harris and Company Law Scholarship (1 award of \$200 for ILC or SIDES)

To be awarded to a graduating student who has or will complete Law 12, excel in his/her studies and who intends to enroll in post-secondary education at a recognized Institute, College or University in British Columbia.

Application Deadline: May 5th

8. Monk Office (1 award of approx. \$700 for ILC or SIDES)

To be awarded to a student pursuing environmental studies. Final amount is calculated as a percentage of qualifying purchases of environmentally friendly products by Saanich School District from Monk Office Supplies.

Application Deadline: May 5th

9. Young WSANEC Woman Leader Award (1 award of \$1000 for District)

Donor to select recipient

to support a graduating female student from the local WSANEC communities who has been active in the community and demonstrated leadership potential
Award presented at Indigenous Graduation ceremony
Full application package to SBO May 5th

10. KWASEN Indigenous Education Scholarship (1 award of \$500 for District)

Donor to select recipient
Awarded to a graduating Indigenous student pursuing education in a full time post-secondary program. Recipient to have demonstrated involvement in leadership and/or cultural involvement in the Arts
Application Deadline: May 5th

11. Joy Paquin Memorial Scholarship (1 award of \$1000 for District)

Donor to select recipient
Awarded to an outstanding graduating student entering full time post-secondary education whose goal is to become a teacher
Application Deadline: May 15th

12. Dianne Cross (1 award of \$750 for District)

Donor to select recipient
Awarded to a graduating student to further enhance study in the Arts or any of: painting, sculpture, fibre, dance, drama, music, or voice.
To be used for artistic development, i.e. tuition, lesson fees, instrument purchase or rental
Application Deadline: May 15th

13. Reid Kyfiuk Memorial Scholarship (1 award of \$1000 for SD61, 62, or 63)

Donor to select recipient
Awarded to a graduating student active in clubs, teams Or community activities and is an active member of a faith group.
Application Deadline: May 15th

14. Marilyn Pinder (2 awards of \$500 for SD63)

District to select recipients
To support an outstanding student entering full-time post-secondary education who has overcome challenges and intends to continue learning a second language.
Application Deadline: May 15th

15. Mosaic Forest Management Scholarship (1 award of \$500 for SD63)

District to select recipient

To support a graduating Indigenous student pursuing studies at a post-secondary program in the field of Forestry. Consideration for Fisheries or other natural resource management fields. Must demonstrate strong leadership skills.

Application Deadline: May 15th
